• Tenant Anti-Harassment Ordinance

- In late September, Council passed updates on the Tenant Anti-Harassment Ordinance (TAHO). These new updates will provide clearer definitions of harassment, require faster repairs, strengthen privacy protections, and impose stricter penalties on landlords who violate tenant rights.
- These protections are expected to be enacted by the end of the year.

Pico-Robertson Community Cleanup

- o On Sunday, October 27th, we will gather for a community cleanup.
- The cleanup is being organized in collaboration with Intiwasi Spanish Immersion School, various synagogues in the community, the Office of Community Beautification, and the Bureau of Sanitation Department.
- We are estimating that 100 participants will attend.

• FALL Festival at Robertson Recreation Center

- o On Wednesday, October 30th, between the hours of 4 and 8 p.m.

The 2nd Annual Great Pumpkin Bash at Pan Pacific Park

- o On Sunday, November 3rd, between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Each year, more than 1.3 billion pumpkins end up dumped in landfills across the US. And as they decay, the pumpkins emit methane, one of the most destructive greenhouse gasses.
- To keep more pumpkins out of landfills, the Councilwoman is organizing The Great Pumpkin Bash at Pan Pacific Park. The event will feature a strike zone hosted by the Los Angeles Dodgers, face painting, bouncy houses, free bike maintenance, and electronic waste collection.
- o Gardening and composting workshops aim at fighting climate change.
