

Dear Los Angeles Department of Transportation,

We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, would like to request that this Agency address unsafe parking practices on the south side of 18th street, between Holt and La Cienega.

This portion of the street consistently has oversized vehicles, such as pickup trucks and RVs, parked on it. This makes it difficult and unsafe for cars to pull into and out of the parking area of the adjacent shopping center. These vehicles also make it extremely hard to see pedestrians, decreasing their safety as well.

The SORO NC requests the City paint red curbs 15 ft before all entrances and exits from the shopping center, as well as all street corners.

Additionally, this portion of 18th St already has a 6000 lbs restriction. We kindly request that the City actively enforce this restriction.
