Dear Senior Lead Officer Ojeda and Councilwoman Yaroslavsky,

The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council (SORO NC) is writing to you on behalf of several Stakeholders that have expressed their concerns about ongoing unsafe conditions that exist on Pico Boulevard and adjacent streets/alleyways, between La Cienega Boulevard and South Robertson Boulevard.

Stakeholders reported to consistently witnessing threatening gestures and indecent exposure by homeless individuals, the use of illegal drugs, used needles and other drug paraphernalia on the ground, encampments that are blocking sidewalks, trash that is attracting vermin, general filth, and other activities that add to making the community feel unsafe.

We request that both the LAPD and the office of Council District 5 pay extra attention to this area and provide actions to alleviate the Stakeholders concerns.

Dear Councilwoman Yaroslavsky and Councilwoman Hutt,

The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council (SORO NC) is writing to you to request that you create a Council File regarding the evaluation of sidewalks during property transfers and/or developments, in order to predetermine the responsibility for future sidewalk repairs.

When a property is sold to a new owner or when a developer changes the use of a property, the City would inspect the sidewalk per LAMC 62.104, with full cost recovery for the inspection. If the sidewalk is in acceptable condition, the full responsibility for maintenance, repair, and liability of the sidewalk would remain solely with the property owner going forward.
