Dear Councilwoman Yaroslavsky,

The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council would like to request that a letter be sent from CD5 to Beverly Bites, 8600 W. Pico Blvd, Suite 117, LA, CA 90035, regarding the public safety hazards created by their delivery drivers. Their delivery drivers double park on Pico Blvd. and on Holt Avenue, park illegally in red zones, and block the public right of way by parking in the alley behind the business. There used to be parking spaces in the alley that are no longer there.

At this time, we request that you address these matters promptly to ensure the safety and well-being of neighborhood residents, visitors, and motorists.

Reported issues include:

- Delivery drivers and customers double-parking on Pico Boulevard and South Holt Avenue
- Vehicles willfully blocking the entrance and exit of South Holt Avenue
- Cars parked illegally in red zones
- Delivery vehicles blocking the public right-of-way by parking in the alley behind your business
- The removal of previously available parking spaces in the alley, exacerbating unsafe conditions

These traffic-related issues create significant risks for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers in the surrounding area.

We respectfully ask that you review your current traffic and parking practices, implement appropriate measures to mitigate these hazards, and inform us of the steps you plan to take to ensure compliance with local regulations. Ensuring proper parking arrangements for your delivery drivers is essential for maintaining public safety and accessibility in our community.
